It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּאֶבֶץ אֱלֹהֵים (הֲאָדֶם בָּאֱבֶץ plugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigץ.

The word אֶבֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.
