	אֶרֶץ׀ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country Hebrew The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 יָדָה יְהוָה אֶת־אֲבֹתָם אֶת־אֱרֶם וְאֶת־לָחִי וְאֶת־חָמֹר וְאֶת־חִיטָן וְאֶת־חִיטָן וְאֶת־חִיטָן hebrew The Hebrew אֶרֶץ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵאשִׁית (אֶרֶץ אֶל־הַתְּהוֹמִים) ESV But the dove found no place to set her foot, and she returned to him to the ark, for the waters were still on the face of the whole earth. So he put out his hand and took her and brought her into the ark with him. NIV But the dove could find no place to set its feet because there was water over all the surface of the earth; so it returned to Noah in the ark. He reached out his hand and took the dove and brought it back to himself in the ark. NLT But the dove could find no place to land because the water still covered the ground. So it returned to the boat, and Noah held out his hand and drew the dove back inside.
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KJV But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

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
