Hebrew	את hebrew
	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by ברא אלהים (עֲרֹת אָבִיו וַיִּגֵּד לְשֵׁנֵי אָחִיו בַּחוּץ
ESV	And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father and told his two brothers outside.
NIV	Ham, the father of Canaan, saw his father's nakedness and told his two brothers outside.
NLT	Ham, the father of Canaan, saw that his father was naked and went outside and told his brothers.
