Meaning

- Not
- Nor
- Neither
- Not even

A combination of the words oὐ (meaning no) and $\delta \epsilon$ (meaning however or but). The word oὐ $\delta \epsilon$ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. oὐ $\delta \epsilon$ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses. It often functions like English "nor" in a correlative pair:

```
οὐ...οὐδέ → "not...nor..."
οὕτε...οὕτε → "neither...nor..."
```

Sometimes, οὐδέ means "not even" when used before a single word for emphasis.

Biblical Examples

Matthew 6:20 plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigMatthew 6:20

Greek θησαυρίζετε δὲ ὑμῖν θησαυροὺς ἐν οὐρανῷ, ὅπου οὔτε σὴς οὕτε βρῶσις ἀφανίζει, καὶ ὅπου κλέπται οὐ διορύσσουσιν οὐδὲ κλέπτουσιν· ESV but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. NIV But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.... - "But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt." - ὅπου οὕτε σὴς οὐδὲ βρῶσις ἀφανίζει \rightarrow οὐδέ joins the two negatives (moth and rust).

Greek καθὼς γέγραπται ὅτι οὐκ ἔστιν δίκαιος οὐδὲ εἶς, ESV as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; NIV As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one; NLT As the Scriptures say, "No one is righteous-- not even one. KJV As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: - "There is none righteous, no, not one" \rightarrow οὐδέ emphasize that no exception exists

μή	not	Negative for commands, wishes, or subjective clauses
οὐδέ	and not / nor / not even	Adds a negative clause or emphasizes exclusion
οὔτε	neither / nor	Used in pairs for parallel structure
