

# ποιέω

Meaning:

- To do
- To make

This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

Present tense forms:

| Person       | Greek Form                   | English Meaning            |
|--------------|------------------------------|----------------------------|
| 1st singular | ποιῶ (contracted from ποιέω) | I do / I make              |
| 2nd singular | ποιεῖς                       | You (singular) do / make   |
| 3rd singular | ποιεῖ                        | He / she / it does / makes |
| 1st plural   | ποιοῦμεν                     | We do / make               |
| 2nd plural   | ποιεῖτε                      | You (plural) do / make     |
| 3rd plural   | ποιοῦσι(ν)                   | They do / make             |

Imperfect tense forms:

| Person       | Greek Form | English Meaning                    |
|--------------|------------|------------------------------------|
| 1st singular | ἐποίουν    | I was doing / making               |
| 2nd singular | ἐποίεις    | You (singular) were doing / making |
| 3rd singular | ἐποίει     | He / she / it was doing / making   |
| 1st plural   | ἐποιοῦμεν  | We were doing / making             |
| 2nd plural   | ἐποιεῖτε   | You (plural) were doing / making   |
| 3rd plural   | ἐποίουν    | They were doing / making           |

Aorist tense:

| Person       | Greek Form | English Meaning           |
|--------------|------------|---------------------------|
| 1st singular | ἐποίησα    | I did / made              |
| 2nd singular | ἐποίησας   | You (singular) did / made |
| 3rd singular | ἐποίησε(ν) | He / she / it did / made  |
| 1st plural   | ἐποιήσαμεν | We did / made             |
| 2nd plural   | ἐποιήσατε  | You (plural) did / made   |
| 3rd plural   | ἐποίησαν   | They did / made           |

Future tense forms:

| Person       | Greek Form | English Meaning               |
|--------------|------------|-------------------------------|
| 1st singular | ποιήσω     | I will do / make              |
| 2nd singular | ποιήσεις   | You (singular) will do / make |
| 3rd singular | ποιήσει    | He / she / it will do / make  |
| 1st plural   | ποιήσομεν  | We will do / make             |
| 2nd plural   | ποιήσετε   | You (plural) will do / make   |

|            |              |                     |
|------------|--------------|---------------------|
| 3rd plural | ποιήσουσι(ν) | They will do / make |
|------------|--------------|---------------------|

Perfect tense forms:

| Person       | Greek Form    | English Meaning                 |
|--------------|---------------|---------------------------------|
| 1st singular | πεποίηκα      | I have done / made              |
| 2nd singular | πεποίηκας     | You (singular) have done / made |
| 3rd singular | πεποίηκε(ν)   | He / she / it has done / made   |
| 1st plural   | πεποιήκαμεν   | We have done / made             |
| 2nd plural   | πεποιήκατε    | You (plural) have done / made   |
| 3rd plural   | πεποιήκασι(ν) | They have done / made           |

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
