Hebrew	ואל כי הריני בוגד נבד יחיד ולא ינח אשׁר הרחיב כפאור נשו ותוא כפנות ולא יצבע האסף אליו כל המים ויכבד אליו כל השמים
ESV	"Moreover, wine is a traitor, an arrogant man who is never at rest. His greed is as wide as Sheol; like death he has never enough. He gathers for himself all nations and collects as his own all peoples."
NIV	Indeed, wine betrays him; he is arrogant and never at rest. Because he is as greedy as the grave and like death is never satisfied, he gathers to himself all the nations and takes captive all the peoples.
NLT	Wealth is treacherous, and the arrogant are never at rest. They open their mouths as wide as the grave, and like death, they are never satisfied. In their greed they have gathered up many nations and swallowed many peoples.
