Meaning

- To kneel
- To bless God as an act of adoration
- To bless man as a benefit
- · Sometimes, to curse

Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament.

The word בַּרַ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope.

Examples

In Scripture, ברך expresses both human and divine blessing:

God blesses humans, conveying favour, prosperity, and life - "And God blessed them and said,
 'Be fruitful and multiply...'" (Genesis 1:28plugin-autotooltip_default plugin autotooltip_bigGenesis 1:28
