Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -יֵם-) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14plugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigDeuteronomy 10:14

Hebrew הָּהֶ וְכָל אֲשֶׁר בָּהּ ESV Behold, to the LORD your God belong heaven and the heaven of heavens, the earth with all that is in it. NIV To the LORD your God belong the heavens, even the highest heavens, the earth and everything in it. ໄδοὺκυρίουτοῦθεοῦσουὁοὐρανὸςκαὶὁοὐρανὸςτοῦοὐρανοῦἡγῆκαὶπάνταὅσαἐστὶνἐναὐτῆ... states that "heaven and the heavens of heavens" belong to God implying layers or realms of heaven.

This word refers to everything above the earth, from the visible sky to the unseen dwelling place of God. Its meaning is context dependent, for example

The word is often paired with the "earth" (אֶרֵץ) to mean "everything"
