It was by faith that Jacob, when he was old and dying, blessed each of Joseph's sons and **NLT** bowed in worship as he leaned on his staff. By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, leaning KIV upon the top of his staff.

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
