Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) χαρὰς ὑπέμεινεν σταυρὸν αἰσχύνης καταφρονήσας, ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. δεξιᾷ τε τοῦ greek The definite article θρόνου τοῦ greek The definite article θεοῦ greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God κεκάθεικεν.
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ESV	looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
NIV	Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
NLT	We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God's throne.
KJV	Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

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
