	Ἀθέτησις μὲν γὰρ γίνεται greek Meaning * To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass Verb. Different from εἰμί (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10 προαγούσης ἐντολῆς διὰ greek Meaning: * Through * Because * On account of Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation. When used with the genitive case, διὰ emphasizes the means or channel by which something happens.John 1:3Matthew 24:12John 1:32 Timothy 2:10Romans 5:1John 1:17 τὸ greek The definite article αὐτῆς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἀσθενὲς καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἄνωφελές,
ESV	On the one hand, a former commandment is set aside because of its weakness and uselessness

NIV	The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless
NLT	Yes, the old requirement about the priesthood was set aside because it was weak and useless.
KJV	For there is verily a disannulling of the commandment going before for the weakness and unprofitableness thereof.
