| Greek | <p>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὧδε μὲν δεκάτας ἀποθνήσκοντες ἄνθρωποι λαμβάνουσιν, ἐκεῖ δὲ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. μαρτυρούμενος ὅτι ζῇ.</p> |
| ESV   | In the one case tithes are received by mortal men, but in the other case, by one of whom it is testified that he lives.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                     |
| NIV   | In the one case, the tenth is collected by men who die; but in the other case, by him who is declared to be living.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                         |
