	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

	* Separately * Apart from * Without * Independently of
	Adverb or preposition (taking the genitive case) that expressing exclusion or lack of association between two things. Occurs 41 times in the New Testament.

	* To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass
	Verb.
	Different from εἶμι (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10 ἄφεις.

ESV	Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.
NIV	In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.
NLT	In fact, according to the law of Moses, nearly everything was purified with blood. For without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness.
KJV	And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

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
