ESV	Where now is your king, to save you in all your cities? Where are all your rulers- those of whom you said, "Give me a king and princes"?
NIV	Where is your king, that he may save you? Where are your rulers in all your towns, of whom you said, 'Give me a king and princes'?
NLT	Now where is your king? Let him save you! Where are all the leaders of the land, the king and the officials you demanded of me?

IT is most frequently translated as “and” διασωσάτω σε ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πάσαιςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπᾶς greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
