

Hosea 4:18

Hebrew	סָר סְבָאָם הַזֶּה הָיָה אֲהָבָו הָבוּ קִלּוֹךְ מִגִּיּוֹתָ
ESV	When their drink is gone, they give themselves to whoring; their rulers dearly love shame.
NIV	Even when their drinks are gone, they continue their prostitution; their rulers dearly love shameful ways.
NLT	When the rulers of Israel finish their drinking, off they go to find some prostitutes. They love shame more than honor.
LXX	ἡρέτισεν Χαναναίους πορνεύοντες ἐξεπόρνευσαν ἡγάπησαν ἀτιμίαν ἐκ φρυάγματος αὐτῶν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
KJV	Their drink is sour: they have committed whoredom continually: her rulers with shame do love, Give ye.
