In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. 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| LXX | <div>σουστροφή πνεύματος οὐ εἶ</div> <div>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί</div> <div>greek</div> <div>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div> <div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
