	פָּנִיםאֲשֶׁר יִשְׁכְּנוּ וּבִקְשׁוּ פָנַי hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. בָּצֵר לָהֶם יִשְׁחַרְנֵנִי
ESV	I will return again to my place, until they acknowledge their guilt and seek my face, and in their distress earnestly seek me.
NIV	Then I will go back to my place until they admit their guilt. And they will seek my face; in their misery they will earnestly seek me.”
NLT	Then I will return to my place until they admit their guilt and turn to me. For as soon as trouble comes, they will earnestly search for me.”

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ὁρθριοῦσι πρὸς greek Meaning * To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
