ESV	Although I trained and strengthened their arms, yet they devise evil against me.
NIV	I trained them and strengthened them, but they plot evil against me.
NLT	I trained them and made them strong, yet now they plot evil against me.
LXX	καὶ γὰρ κατισχυσα τοὺς αὐτῶν ὦς, ἡ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) καὶ αὐτῶν αὐτῶν αὐτῇ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" εἰς ἐμὲ ἐλογίσαντο πονηρά
KJV	Though I have bound and strengthened their arms, yet do they imagine mischief against me.

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
