Hebrew	הִיָּה hebrew The word הִיָּה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 עָנָה בְּלִי הַפִּיכָה
	ESV Ephraim mixes himself with the peoples; Ephraim is a cake not turned.
	NIV “Ephraim mixes with the nations; Ephraim is a flat cake not turned over.
	NLT “The people of Israel mingle with godless foreigners, making themselves as worthless as a half-baked cake!
LXX	Εφραιμ ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τοῖς greek The definite article λαοῖς αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) συνανεμίγυστο Εφραιμ ἐγένετο ἐγκρυφίας οὐ μεταστρεφόμενος
	KJV Ephraim, he hath mixed himself among the people; Ephraim is a cake not turned.
