This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בָּ הָיָה בְּכָל יְמֵי תַפְצֵץ
ESV	Israel is swallowed up; already they are among the nations as a useless vessel.
NIV	Israel is swallowed up; now she is among the nations like a worthless thing.
NLT	The people of Israel have been swallowed up; they lie among the nations like an old discarded pot.
