| NLT    | “What sorrow awaits Assyria, the rod of my anger. I use it as a club to express my anger. |

|     | <div>greek</div> <div>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div> <div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
