Hebrew	יהוה יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	And his delight shall be in the fear of the LORD. He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide disputes by what his ears hear,

NLT	He will delight in obeying the LORD. He will not judge by appearance nor make a decision based on hearsay.

The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses.
