	קָרַב plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big קָרַב hebrew Meaning Hebrew * Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 קָדוֹשׁ יִשְׂרָאֵל
ESV	Shout, and sing for joy, O inhabitant of Zion, for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.”
NIV	Shout aloud and sing for joy, people of Zion, for great is the Holy One of Israel among you.”
NLT	Let all the people of Jerusalem shout his praise with joy! For great is the Holy One of Israel who lives among you.”

LXX	ἀγαλλιᾶσθε καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences.
