	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 כְּשֹׁד מִשְׁדֵּי יְהוָה
ESV	Wail, for the day of the LORD is near; as destruction from the Almighty it will come!
NIV	Wail, for the day of the LORD is near; it will come like destruction from the Almighty.
NLT	Scream in terror, for the day of the LORD has arrived- the time for the Almighty to destroy.
