Hebrew	* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 פָּצְחוּ רִנָּה
ESV	The whole earth is at rest and quiet; they break forth into singing.
NIV	All the lands are at rest and at peace; they break into singing.
NLT	But finally the earth is at rest and quiet. Now it can sing again!

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology". It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 βοῶ μετ εὐφροσύνης
KJV	The whole earth is at rest, and is quiet: they break forth into singing.
