Hebrew	אֶרֶץ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאֶרֶץ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 צִלְצַל כְּנָפַיִם אֲשֶׁר מֵעֵבֶר לְנַהֲרֵי כּוּשׁ
ESV	Ah, land of whirring wings that is beyond the rivers of Cush,
NIV	Woe to the land of whirring wings along the rivers of Cush,
NLT	Listen, Ethiopia- land of fluttering sails that lies at the headwaters of the Nile,
LXX	οὐαὶ γῆς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγῆς Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX: Genesis 1:1 Genesis 2:7 Genesis 12:1 πλοίων πτέρυγες ἐπέκεινα ποταμῶν Αἰθιοπίας
