ESV	For thus the Lord said to me: "Go, set a watchman; let him announce what he sees.

LXX	ὅτι οὕτως εἶπεν κύριος πρὸς greek Meaning * To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἄν ἵδης ἀνάγγελον
