

Isaiah 23:10

Hebrew	אֶרֶץ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 כִּי־אֶרֶץ בֵּית תִּרְשִׁישׁ אֵין מִזַּח עוֹד
ESV	Cross over your land like the Nile, O daughter of Tarshish; there is no restraint anymore.
NIV	Till your land as along the Nile, O Daughter of Tarshish, for you no longer have a harbor.
NLT	Come, people of Tarshish, sweep over the land like the flooding Nile, for Tyre is defenseless.
LXX	ἐργάζου τῇ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ, ἡ, τό greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big γῇ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 σου καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big καί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” γὰρ πλοῖα οὐκέτι ἔρχεται ἐκ Καρχηδόνας
KJV	Pass through thy land as a river, O daughter of Tarshish: there is no more strength.

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
