Hebrew	תָּהוּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big תָּהוּ hebrew Meaning: * Formless * Waste * Futile * Meaningless * Nothing * Chaos Masculine. Noun. Describes something that is unformed or purposeless. It often pairs with בָּהוּ - void -forming the phrase תָּהוּ וְבָהוּ, a poetic expression for utter chaos or emptiness. ESV	The wasted city is broken down; every house is shut up so that none can enter.
NIV	The ruined city lies desolate; the entrance to every house is barred.
NLT	The city writhes in chaos; every home is locked to keep out intruders.

Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
