	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

ESV	For the hand of the LORD will rest on this mountain, and Moab shall be trampled down in his place, as straw is trampled down in a dunghill.
NIV	The hand of the LORD will rest on this mountain; but Moab will be trampled under him as straw is trampled down in the manure.
NLT	For the LORD's hand of blessing will rest on Jerusalem. But Moab will be crushed. It will be like straw trampled down and left to rot.

It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning τρόπον πατοῦσιν ἄλωνα ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀμάξαις
