Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as
“and” ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν

Preposition meaning “in”. νυκτὶ ἔσταιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί

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εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example
εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐλπὶς πονηρὰ μάθετε ἀκούειν

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
