ESV	Does he who plows for sowing plow continually? does he continually open and harrow his ground?
NIV	When a farmer plows for planting, does he plow continually? Does he keep on breaking up and harrowing the soil?
NLT	Does a farmer always plow and never sow? Is he forever cultivating the soil and never planting?
LXX	μὴ ὄλην τὴν greek The definite article ἡμέραν μέλλει ὁ greek The definite article ἀροτριῶν ἀροτριᾶν ἡ σπόρον προετοιμάσει πρὶν ἐργάσασθαι τὴν greek The definite article γῆν Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1
KJV	Doth the plowman plow all day to sow? doth he open and break the clods of his ground?

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
