ESV	and the oxen and the donkeys that work the ground will eat seasoned fodder, which has been winnowed with shovel and fork.
NIV	The oxen and donkeys that work the soil will eat fodder and mash, spread out with fork and shovel.
NLT	The oxen and donkeys that till the ground will eat good grain, its chaff blown away by the wind.
