ESV	Your cords hang loose; they cannot hold the mast firm in its place or keep the sail spread out. Then prey and spoil in abundance will be divided; even the lame will take the prey.
NIV	Your rigging hangs loose: The mast is not held secure, the sail is not spread. Then an abundance of spoils will be divided and even the lame will carry off plunder.
NLT	The enemies' sails hang loose on broken masts with useless tackle. Their treasure will be divided by the people of God. Even the lame will take their share!

The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).		
It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning παραδοθῇ εἰς προνομὴν τοίνυν πολλοὶ χωλοὶ προνομὴν ποιήσουσιν
