	Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in ים-) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 חֶרֶב־הַיָּהּ עַל־אֶדְוֹם תִּרְדּוּ וְעַל־עַם חֶרְמִי לְמִשְׁפָּט
