Hebrew	וַיִּעֲפּוּ הַנְּעָרִים וַיִּגְעוּ וּבַחֲוָרִים כָּשׁוּל יִכָּשְׁלוּ
ESV	Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted;
NIV	Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;
NLT	Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion.
LXX	πεινάσουσιν γὰρ νεώτεροι καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” κοπιάσουσιν νεανίσκοι καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐκλεκτοὶ ἀνίσχυες ἔσονται greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
