	Meaning
	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 כְּבוֹד יְהוָהוּ בְּאֵימֹת יְהוָה
ESV	Let them give glory to the LORD, and declare his praise in the coastlands.
NIV	Let them give glory to the LORD and proclaim his praise in the islands.
NLT	Let the whole world glorify the LORD; let it sing his praise.

LXX	δώσουσιν τῷ greek The definite article θεῷ greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God δόξαν τὰς greek The definite article ἀρετὰς αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
