ESV	Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: “I am the first and I am the last; besides me there is no god.
NIV	“This is what the LORD says- Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God.
NLT	This is what the LORD says- Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD of Heaven's Armies: “I am the First and the Last; there is no other God.

LXX	οὕτως λέγει ὁ greek The definite article θεὸς greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God ὁ greek The definite article βασιλεὺς τοῦ greek The definite article ἰσραηλ ὁ greek The definite article ῥυσάμενος αὐτόν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) θεὸς greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God σαβαωθ ἐγὼ πρῶτος καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐγὼ μετὰ ταῦτα greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 πλὴν ἐμοῦ οὐκ ἔστιν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. θεός greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God
