Hebrew	אֲדַגְּי יְהוָה פָּתַח לִי אָזְנוֹ וְאֵנִי לֹא מְרִיתִי אַחֲזֹר לֹא נִסְגַּנְתִּי
ESV	The Lord GOD has opened my ear, and I was not rebellious; I turned not backward.
NIV	The Sovereign LORD has opened my ears, and I have not been rebellious; I have not drawn back.
NLT	The Sovereign LORD has spoken to me, and I have listened. I have not rebelled or turned away.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἡ greek The definite article παιδεία κυρίου ἀνοίγει μου τὰ greek The definite article ὥτα ἐγὼ δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οὐκ ἀπειθῶ οὐδὲ ἀντιλέγω
KJV	The Lord GOD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back.

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
