LXX	ἰδοὺ ἐγὼ κτίζω σε οὐχ ὥς χαλκεὺς φουσῶν ἄνθρακας καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἐκφέρων σκευὸς εἰς ἔργον ἐγὼ δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἔκτισά σε οὐκ εἰς ἀπώλειαν φθεῖραι
