	יהוה לא מחשבותי מחשבותיכם ולא דרכיכם דרכי נאם יהוה יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. NIV	“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the LORD.
NLT	“My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts,” says the LORD. “And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine.
LXX	οὐ γάρ εἰσιν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. αἱ greek The definite article βουλαί μου ὥσπερ αἱ greek The definite article βουλαὶ ὑμῶν οὐδὲ ὥσπερ αἱ greek The definite article ὁδοὶ ὑμῶν αἱ greek The definite article ὁδοὶ μου λέγει κύριος
