	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article מַעֲשֻׂיִּדּ וְלָא Genesis 1:1.
ESV	I will declare your righteousness and your deeds, but they will not profit you.
NIV	I will expose your righteousness and your works, and they will not benefit you.
NLT	Now I will expose your so-called good deeds. None of them will help you.
