	יהִי־יהִיplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהִי hebrew The word יהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 יהִי תִפְאֶרֶת בְּיַד יְהוָהplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהִי hebrew Meaning Hebrew * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. 	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. στέφανος κάλλους ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν
