|     | <p>יהוה <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span> יהוה?</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* Yahweh - God's personal name</p> <p>It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.</p> <p>First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 <span>הַשָּׁמַיִם</span><span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span> שָׁמַיִם</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meanings:</p> <p>* Heaven or heavens * Sky * Compass</p> <p>Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 <span>וְהָאָרֶץ</span><span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span> אָרֶץ</p> <p>hebrew</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country</p> <p>The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.</p> <p>When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 <span>הַדִּם רַגְלִי אֵי זֶה בַּיִת אֲשֶׁר תִּבְנֶנּוּ לִי וְאֵי זֶה מְקוֹם מְנוּחָתִי</span></p> |

|     | <p>οὕτως λέγει κύριος ὁ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article οὐρανός</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens</p> <p>278 occurrences in the New Testament.</p> <p>Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 μοι θρόνος ἡ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article δέ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. γῆ</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)</p> <p>Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.</p> <p>It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ὑποπόδιον τῶν</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article ποδῶν μου ποῖον οἶκον οἰκοδομήσετέ μοι ἢ ποῖος τόπος τῆς</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article καταπαύσεώς μου</p> |
