	The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by אֱלֹהִים (אֱלֹהִים הַכֹּהֵן וְאֶת־אֱלֹהִים) plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big
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ESV	And I will get reliable witnesses, Uriah the priest and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah, to attest for me.”
NIV	And I will call in Uriah the priest and Zechariah son of Jeberechiah as reliable witnesses for me.”
NLT	I asked Uriah the priest and Zechariah son of Jeberechiah, both known as honest men, to witness my doing this.
