Hebrew	אַרְצֵךְ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאַרְצֵךְ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אַרְצֵךְ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 הִתְאַזְרוּ וְחַתּוּ וְחַתּוּ הִתְאַזְרוּ וְחַתּוּ
ESV	Be broken, you peoples, and be shattered; give ear, all you far countries; strap on your armor and be shattered; strap on your armor and be shattered.
NIV	Raise the war cry, you nations, and be shattered! Listen, all you distant lands. Prepare for battle, and be shattered! Prepare for battle, and be shattered!
NLT	“Huddle together, you nations, and be terrified. Listen, all you distant lands. Prepare for battle, but you will be crushed! Yes, prepare for battle, but you will be crushed!
LXX	καὶ ἔθνη καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἡττάσθε ἐπακούσατε ἕως ἐσχάτου τῆς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ἡ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἡ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX: Genesis 1:1 Genesis 2:7 Genesis 12:1 ἰσχυρότερος ἡττάσθε ἐὰν γὰρ πάλιν ἰσχύσητε πάλιν ἡττηθήσεσθε
KJV	Associate yourselves, O ye people, and ye shall be broken in pieces; and give ear, all ye of far countries: gird yourselves, and ye shall be broken in pieces; gird yourselves, and ye shall be broken in pieces.

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
