Greek Meaning	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" οὐκ ἐκ πίστεως μόνον.

NIV	You see that a person is justified by what he does and not by faith alone.
NLT	So you see, we are shown to be right with God by what we do, not by faith alone.
KJV	Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.

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
