	Τίς σοφὸς καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐπιστήμων ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ὑμῖν; δεῖξάτω ἐκ τῆς greek The definite article καλῆς ἀναστροφῆς τὰ greek The definite article ἔργα αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πραύτητι σοφίας.
ESV	Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom.
NIV	Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show it by his good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom.
NLT	If you are wise and understand God's ways, prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom.
KJV	Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.

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
