IT is most frequently translated as “and” καλύψει πλῆθος ἁμαρτιῶν.
ESV	let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins.
NIV	remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will save him from death and cover over a multitude of sins.
NLT	you can be sure that whoever brings the sinner back will save that person from death and bring about the forgiveness of many sins.
KJV	Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

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
