	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 אָת plugin-autotooltip_default plugin- autotooltip_big אַת

	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵבֵׁי עַמִּׁי לְהִשָּׁבֵעַ בִּשְׁמִי חַי יְהוָּה plugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_big יְהוָּה

	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	lt is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָּה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
